Height Gain Challenge

What is this competition all about?

A challenge to all Cayley members to achieve the highest altitude gain above launch (without breaking airspace or NOTAMs).

Rules

Launch at any of the valid Cayley Club sites.

Bridlington.
Cayton Bay
Filey (either take off).
Hole of Horcum.
Mappleton (not official Cayley site)
Millington.
Primrose.
Reighton lower take off.
Reighton upper take off.

Scoring

Points are awarded for the highest 3 altitudes gains at each of the sites.

Points awarded are as follows: -
Highest altitude gain: 3 points
2nd highest altitude gain: 2 points.
3rd highest altitude gain: 1 point.

Entering

Your GPS track log (IGC file) will be used to validate your times. The difference between the launch height on the log and the maximum height on the log is the maximum height gained. Please send the IGC to davidperryman759@gmail.com for validation and challenge inclusion. A valid IGC log must be in the correct pilot's name and less than 15 days old.

All 9 launch site points are added together for each member. A single member can achieve the highest, 2nd and 3rd highest by submitting valid flight logs.

The member with the most points at the end of the challenge period wins.

Competition Dates

The competition runs from the 1st of February to the 31st of January.
