What is this competition about?

Fly XC from any of our coastal sites to win.

Rules

Your whole flight will be measured as you leave the coast line. You have to fly more than 5km to qualify and land 1km away from the coast line.

Entering

Available to all members with a GPS that can download IGC files and upload them to the www.xcleague.co.uk.

Safety

Please remember that 360ing at the coast is extremely dangerous and figure of 8 patterns should be used.

Remember there can be extreme rotor behind the cliff and therefore sufficient height should be gained before going over the back.
