Welcome to the second Sir George Cayley Sailwing Club Competition & Challenges Newsletter.

The intent of this newsletter is to celebrate the success of club competitions and challenges.

Forward Note

The Cayley Club has many sites, mostly coastal, but very interesting and in some cases challenging, especially as the coastal winds can change quickly. The current competitions include coastal runs, XCs, glides, accuracy and photography.

New competitions and challenges for 2019 include Reighton, Primrose & Filey cylinders, height gain and Coupe I-Brid.

Competitions and Challenges Update

A few new entries for the 2018 and 2019 competitions and challenges, notably:- Steve Charlesworth has extended his lead in the 'Most XC points from XC flight from a Cayley site' (53.5 points), Gary Senior has moved into second place (29.6 points) and Geoff Mosses is in 3rd (28.9 points). There are still a few weeks to go to the end of the competition (31 January 2019).

David Perryman is leading the 'Coastal Races' with a time of 21 minutes 17 seconds, 10 points (Bridlington) (No other entries!). No entries for the Mappleton leg yet. There are still a few weeks to go to the end of the competition (31 January 2019).

Only two entries so far in the 2019 'Most XC points from XC flight from a Cayley site' and 'Longest coastal XC from a Cayley site', both currently led by Steve Charlesworth.

The photography competition is open and we welcome photographs in readiness for the voting to take place shortly after the 31 January 2019. Please send your Cayley related photographs to comps@cayleyparagliding.co.uk. There are 8 entries so far.

Notable Cayley member things; XC, achievements etc

Steve Charlesworth has flown from Mappleton, past the Tunstall turn point (Coastal race), over the Tunstall gap, past Withernsea and landed at Eastington (37.6km coastal XC, 33.9 km open distance).

Steve Charlesworth has also beaten the current recorded height gain at Mappleton. The record now stands at 259 feet above take off.
