## RHADS.

The question was asked how to use RHADS. For those who don't know, the Derbyshire soaring club have an arrangement where for a given wind direction, airspace in the Upton and Worksop Corridors are temporally changed. to allow pilots to fly at higher altitudes without encroaching airspace. In order to take advantage of this, pilots need to attend a briefing and to be entered onto the list of Pilots who are permitted to fly through these corridors. Andy Berzins is to liaise with Derbyshire club to see when there will be another briefing.

## Old Kit
